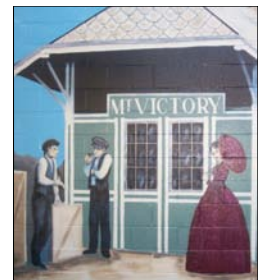
Day One

County & Township Roads - since many of Hardin County’s roads are two lane, they’re ideal for leisurely travels thru the country. Before you come, be sure to download the Old Order Amish Brochure from the Alliance website at www.HardinOhio.org. It includes a map which will work great for a tour thru the southern part of the county.



Old Order Amish Country - the roads thru this area are mostly flat with minimal turns and hills. You’ll be able to also travel at your own pace through the countryside. Watch for signs at the end of the Amish lanes selling handmade products or fresh produce. Be sure to stop if you see something that interests you. *No Sunday sales.*

Village of Mount Victory - this small village is located in the southern part of Hardin County includes a quaint Main Street area with over 12 shops perfect for finding antiques and special treasures. Admire the mural at Henry Martin Park or stroll along their Historic Walking Tour. *Gas and food are available. Most shops are open Thursday thru Sunday.*

Day Two



Historic Courthouse District Tour - use the Walking Tour brochure to tour Kenton’s downtown area. Along the way you’ll pass various churches built in the late 1800’s to early 1900’s, the Hardin County Courthouse and Hardin County Armory, Gene Autry Mural & Park, plus many unique downtown buildings and historic homes. For a brochure, visit the Alliance website at www.HardinOhio.org. *Gas and food are available.*



Ohio Historical Markers - use our “Road Less Traveled” Visitor’s Guide to locate the markers in Hardin County. Or choose to find your way along Hull’s Trail, once a rough military trail used during the War of 1812. While on your search, you’ll pass thru the historic Scioto Marsh and journey along some of Hardin County’s scenic country roads.



Village of Ada - discover quaint shops and the campus of Ohio Northern University. Sites to see in Ada include the Remington Walk, Dial-Roberson Stadium and the Historic Railroad Depot & Park. This also makes for another great break along your tour. *Gas and food are available.*
