## *Great Outdoors Tour*



Enjoy the Great Outdoors in Hardin County. Whether your plans include bird watching, golfing, fishing or even just walking, we have an entire county filled with wonderful places for you to experience nature.

### Day One

**Lawrence Woods State Nature Preserve** - located south of Kenton, this 1,035-acre site brings nature lovers of all kinds to trek the Preserve's boardwalk and get back to nature. Brochures are available on site for locating the numerous plants and animals living in the Preserve. Maintained by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources - Division of Nature Preserves, it's perfect for bird watching and enjoying any time of the year. *Open seven days a week, dusk to dawn.*



**Silver Creek Environmental Center** - follow the self-guided nature trail at this learning laboratory for ecological study. Maintained by the Hardin County Soil & Water Conservation District, the Center includes scenic woodlands, meadow, streamlet, bridge and shelter house. *Group outings are by appointment only.*

**France Lake at Saulisberry Park** - maintained by the City of Kenton, this lake is a great place for fishing and camping. Also includes a playground area and shelter house. *City Permit is required for fishing.*

### Day Two



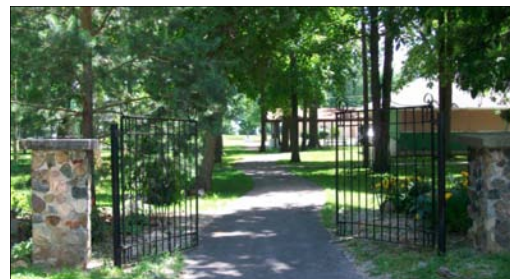
**Veterans Memorial Park Golf Course** - located in Kenton, this 18-hole golf course is challenging yet enjoyable and features a world class tee box on hole six. From the longest tees it offers 6,315 yards of golf for a par of 72.

**Boy Scout Lake at Veterans Memorial Park District** - park includes fishing, playground, basketball court and shelter houses. New additions to the park include a walking track and dog run.



**Remington Walk** - located on the campus of Ohio Northern University in Ada, this outdoor display features twelve cast bronze statues by noted artists Frederic Remington, Charles Russell and James Fraser.

**Gormley Park** - located in Forest, this well shaded park includes a log cabin built in 1903 and a small pond, in addition to a shelter house perfect for a picnic. Site also has basketball, volleyball and tennis courts, horseshoe pits, baseball fields, a walking path, and a playground.
