Step Back In Time Tour



Hardin County is filled with historic markers and unique buildings listed on the National Registry of Historic Places. Whether you plan to stroll along one of our walking tours or drive our scenic country roads, be sure to expect along your way impressive architecture and small town charm.

Day One

Hardin County Sullivan-Johnson Museum - built in ca. 1896, this Queen Anne style mansion features an extensive display of Gene Autry Repeating Cap Pistols manufactured by the former Kenton Hardware Company, as well as their popular cast iron toys. Also on display is the Nation's First Congressional Medal of Honor, given to Kenton native Jacob Parrot in 1863. *Open Monday thru Friday from 1 - 4 pm and some Sundays.*



Historic Courthouse District Walking Tour - as you walk along this tour, you'll pass various churches built in the late 1800's to early 1900's, plus the Hardin County Courthouse and Hardin County Armory. You'll also see many unique features of downtown buildings, the Gene Autry Mural & Park, plus historic homes.

Overnight Accommodations

Grand Trillium Inn, located at 408 N. Main Street in Kenton, this 1870's historic, three-story estate is an upscale bed & breakfast with five guest rooms including two suites with private baths and three rooms with shared bath. Amenities include full breakfast, afternoon tea and wireless internet.

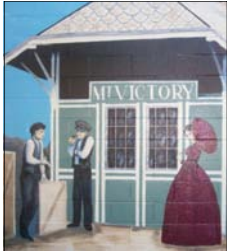

Day Two



Village of Mount Victory - located in the southern part of Hardin County, this small village includes a quaint Main Street area with over 12 shops where you can find antiques, crafts and special treasures. Admire the mural at Henry Martin Park, stroll along their Historic Walking Tour or visit the beautiful gardens surrounding some of the shops. *Most shops are open Thursday through Sunday.*



Ohio Historical Markers - use our "Road Less Traveled" Visitor's Guide to locate the markers in Hardin County. Or choose to find your way along Hull's Trail, once a rough military trail used during the War of 1812. While on your search, you'll drive thru the Scioto Marsh and along some of Hardin County's many scenic country roads.



Hardin County Historical Village & Farm - site includes a one-room school house, log cabin, woodworkers building and barn filled with antique farm machinery and relics. *Not open regular hours, however from May 22 to September 25 the schoolhouse is open every Saturday from 10 am - 2 pm and children's programs will be held weekly in July.
